As Central Government by notification, constituted a Commission, to be known as the National Commission for Homoeopathy, to exercise the powers conferred upon, and to perform the functions assigned to it, under NCH Act 2020. As per section 59 (2) of NCH Act, 2020, following has been stated:

“Notwithstanding the repeal of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act 1973, the educational and medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made thereunder: Provided that anything done or any action taken as regards the educational and medical standards and requirements under the enactment under repeal and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall be deemed to have been done or taken under the corresponding provision of this Act and shall continue in force accordingly unless and until superseded by anything or by any action taken under this Act”.

As per provision in the Act, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy has been constituted with the mandate to grant permission to the existing and new medical institution of Homoeopathy. Accordingly, it is to inform you that all the relevant documents submitted by your college in Part-1 proforma were examined by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.

2. On careful consideration of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board has arrived at the following conclusion:-

That the applicant has set up a Homoeopathic Medical College with the component of staff, infrastructure, equipment and instruments and other facilities where as the College has to take certain time bound steps to implement Minimum Standard Requirements of the Homoeopathy College and attached Hospital as prescribed by the National Commission for Homoeopathy for conducting BHMS course in Homoeopathy.

- A. The College has provided list of 16 guest faculty out of which not a single GF eligible as Affidavits are not provided.
- B. The College has provided a list of 13 part time teachers of Modern Medicine out of which 06 are eligible as 07 teachers are same as Guest Faculty and no other documents provided.
- C. **Website:** <http://www.bhmc.edu.in/> - website is functional but OPD/IPD data & student's data not uploaded.
3. After considering the provisions of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013, permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board is issued to **Bhartesh Homoeopathic Medical College, B.C.-188, Old P.B. Road Dharwar, Belgaum for undergraduate I-BHMS course in 100 seats and MD (Hom) course in 3 subjects namely Materia Medica, Repertory and Organon of Medicine with 6 seats in each for the academic session year 2021-22. The College Principal is directed to fulfill the deficiencies within three months and an affidavit in this regard may be submitted to the Medical Assessment Board within a period of one week.**
4. All admissions in Under Graduate and Post graduate course shall be through NEET/AIAPGET only. It is further informed that, minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India quota. The counseling for seats under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling Authority of State / UT Government as designated by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling Authority of that State / UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the student admitted thereunder.
5. The category wise list of selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET/AIAPGET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board as per rules.



Bhartesh Homoeopathic Medical College, Belgaum, Karnataka is functional since 1982 has submitted an application for permission for sanction of 100 seats in BHMS course and 18 seats in Postgraduate course [MD(Hom.)] for the academic year 2023-24. The College has submitted the Part I information in which the entire functional profile has been narrated. Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy (MARBH) has examined the profile of the College as to whether the college fulfils the minimum standards to be fulfilled as per the prevailing regulations under NCH Act, 2020.

MARBH has examined the application and observes that the College shall fulfil the following functional requirements as per the Minimum Standard Requirement:

(a) Collegiate Hospital:

- Case Sheet with Name, Age, Sex, Address and Contact Phone No. of patient, Presenting Complaints, Prescription, Referral/IPD Admission with signature of the consulting doctor etc. is not submitted. IPD and OPD cases (12 cases for last one year) shall be submitted for verification.
- These documents and follow up attendance of patients shall be made available in the medical record room for academic purposes of students.
- Lab investigation reports should be maintained properly in case records.
- Disease diagnosis shall be recorded in all case records as per ICD 11 criteria.

The above shortfalls observed in your College shall be rectified within a period of 15 days and the compliance report shall be submitted to the MARBH failing which the conditional permission issued will be withdrawn without further notice. Considering the above observations, and facilities available, MARBH has decided to issue **conditional permission to Bhartesh Homoeopathic Medical College, B.C.- 188, Old P. B. Road Dharwar, Belgaum, Karnataka with admission intake capacity of 100 seats for Undergraduate (BHMS) course and 18 seats in Postgraduate Course [MD(Hom.)], Organon of Medicine (06 seats), Materia Medica (06 seats), Repertory (06 seats) for academic year 2023 - 24.**

It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 100 UG seats shall be treated as All India Quota. The counseling for seats under All India Quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority of State/UT Govt. as designated by Central Government/NCH for the A.Y. 2023-24 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCH for All India Quota or the students admitted thereunder.

The Medical Assessment and Rating Board has examined the profile of the College as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Essential Standards to be fulfilled as per the prevailing regulations under clause 28 of NCH Act 2020,

On careful examination of the application, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board has observed the following shortfalls as per MSR requirements:

1. Teaching faculty

- Acquittance role provided without stamp

2. OPD and IPD Department

- OPD Patients average per day -232.60 against requirement of 250 per day

3. Hospital details:

- IPD register does not have the prescription and follow up details.
- Lab investigation register is submitted for the year 2022-23.
- Medicine stock register is submitted with signatures but without any date.

Considering the above observations and facilities available, medical assessment and Rating board has decided to issue **Conditional Permission to Bhartesh Homoeopathic Medical College, B.C.-188, Old P.B. Road Dharwar, Belgaum-590016 with admission intake capacity of 100 seats for undergraduate (BHMS) and 18 seats in postgraduate course in MD (Hom) course in 03 subjects namely Organon of Medicine (06 seats), Materia Medica (06seats) and Repertory (06 Seats) for the academic year 2024-25.**

All deficiencies noticed shall be rectified within a period of one month and the compliance report shall be submitted for verification.

All admissions shall be made for NEET/AIAPGET qualified candidates only. Counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective Counseling Authority of State/ UT govt as designated by Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85 % seats or as the case may be shall be conducted by the concerned counseling authority of the state/UT.

The category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET/AIAPGET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.

Counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective Counseling Authority of State/UT govt as designated by Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be shall be conducted by the concerned counseling authority of the state/UT.
4. The Category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET/ AIAPGET qualified students and without permission of counseling board will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.
